Then week #2 - Romans 1:16 – "I am **not ashamed of the gospel** of Christ" Today: "I am not ashamed" – A Testimony Of Triumph!

2 Timothy 1:12

For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.

I. The Tests Of Life.

"For the which cause I also suffer these things:"

The Author - Paul:

Had written (as far as we know) Hebrews 12:1-2

"let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Looking unto Jesus..."

- Now this letter to Timothy His last written words. 2 Timothy 4:6-7
 6. For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand.
 - 7. I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith:

2 Great Tests: Pleasure and Pain.

- What do we do when we are offered a good time now, pleasures for a season, and have to choose between Him and them?
- What do we do when it hurts, or inconveniences, or costs to love and serve Jesus?

Text: Paul Writes From A Place of Perspective.

It is almost over.

To the very end – troubles.

Text:

1:8 – Don't be ashamed that I am in prison.

Rumors. Criminal #1.

1:15 – Most in Asia – embarrassed by Paul and "turned away"

1:16 – Onesiphorus – "refreshed me and was not ashamed" 4:10+

Demas forsaken, having loved this present world Others

Alone. Cold. Facing death.

2 Corinthians 11 (NLT)- A quick list of the price he paid –

- 23. ... I have worked harder, been put in prison more often, been whipped times without number, and faced death again and again.
- 24. Five different times the Jewish leaders gave me thirty-nine lashes.
- 25. Three times I was beaten with rods. Once I was stoned. Three times I was shipwrecked. Once I spent a whole night and a day adrift at sea.
- 26. I have traveled on many long journeys. I have faced danger from rivers and from robbers. I have faced danger from my own people, the Jews, as well as from the Gentiles. I have faced danger in the cities, in the deserts, and on the seas. And I have faced danger from men who claim to be believers but are not.
- 27. I have worked hard and long, enduring many sleepless nights. I have been hungry and thirsty and have often gone without food. I have shivered in the cold, without enough clothing to keep me warm.
- 28. Then, besides all this, I have the daily burden of my concern for all the churches.

Think of it as an interview with Paul:

"Paul, you wrote that we would not be ashamed of the hope we have in Christ – the hope of glory.

It doesn't look like it is working out well for you..."

Where is the glorious? It seems more gory than glory

No Pleasure. Lots of Pain and Problems!

What about it? Was what you wrote and hoped-really true?

II. Testimony.

What?

<u>"Ashamed"</u>:

Disadvantaged. Embarrassed. Disfigured or handicapped. "SHAMED".

Paul-

Not the day I met Jesus.

Actually- the only shame Paul continually references is the life he lived without Jesus!

Not since that day I met Jesus.

Not now.

Not ever!

How???

III. Truths

Paul had written -

Romans 1:16 – "I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ...

Roman 10:11 – "For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed."

Now –

- The gospel had never failed!
- No one had ever trusted Jesus and been ashamed!

Jesus – Never failed!

"I know whom" – It's personal!

cf. 4:17- "Notwithstanding the Lord stood with me, and strengthened me"

"I have believed"

"am persuaded" – Confidence. Assurance.

"He is able..."

"to keep

"against that day" – Future perspective.

4:8 – "Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness which the Lord the righteous judge, shall give me at that day"

So what?

How can we live unashamed, confident, bold... In such a way that we will pass the tests of life

- Pleasures
- Pains/Problems/Price

Have you ever been really ashamed of something you did?

- None when we chose Jesus!
- All when we deviated and did it "our way"

How can this reality be ours? "I am not ashamed"
