# Why We Need to Be Saved—The Problem Selected Scriptures

**SermonAudio Blurb**: To be a person who is in a right relationship toward his or her Creator is the most critical issue anyone faces. The common way this is described is whether a person is "saved" or not. Unfortunately this concept, though a central theme of the bible, is misunderstood by many, even within the church. What does it mean? What does it entail? Why is it so important? And how does one know if they are saved? These are the sort of questions this small series will seek to explain. This is a basic explanation of why we need salvation and what that means. In the first sermon we will see the problem we all face, sin.

# I. Introduction.

- A. We are gong to step away from the book of Acts and the book of Psalms for a few Sundays. Grayson and I want to help explain what makes a person a Christian. Or, how to be saved.
- B. The Christian faith rises and falls upon that issue.
- C. What we want to do behind all of this is to give each of you the information you need to share the gospel and how to be saved to others.
- D. What we hope you will do is use these sermons as a tool by marking in your bible in such a way that you can use it when speaking to someone about the gospel and salvation.
- E. We are going to break this down into four sermons dealing with four parts to the idea of being saved.
  - 1. First, the problem.
  - 2. Second, the solution.
  - 3. Third, the commands.
  - 4. Four, the benefits.
- F. From there we want to do approximately four more sermons that are in light of what we just taught. The plan is to look at some of the alternate messages out there who say this is how a person is saved.
  - 1. Roman Catholic Church.

- 2. Islam.
- 3. Mormonism.
- 4. Jehovah Witnesses.
- G. Today we will see the problem with which all of mankind is confronted.
  - 1. Some people talk about this being the bad news that tells us why we need to know and believe the good news, or the gospel.
  - 2. No one with half a brain would deny that there is something seriously wrong with this universe. From catastrophic natural events such as earthquakes, tsunamis and such, to the horror of war, to the great harm inflicted from disease, to the crippling effects of poverty and starvation. Governments, from the beginning of recorded history show incredible ability to afflict the people with every imagined sort of wrong.
  - 3. Add to this the sort of things done by us or to us as individuals. People have suffered molestation, sexual abuse, physical abuse, torture, maining and murder. We have lied and been lied to. We have hated and been hated. And the list goes on and on. Some in this room carry deep scars from things you yourself did or had done to you.
  - 4. Why? And how is this resolved?
- H. Reject the Christian faith and I will say that you reject the only thing that makes sense of this mess.
- I. That is the problem as most people see it. But in reality bone cancer in children, typhoid fever and rape and murder and mayhem are all just consequences. They are not the real problem; rather, they are the fruit of a root problem.
  - 1. When you have a person who is offended, bitter or angry over some evil done to them or harm suffered; you will find them asking something along the lines of, "Where was your God when I was being raped?" And this knocks many back in silence.
  - 2. You don't have to shy away from the overt evil seen today.
    - a. You can nod with true sympathy and agree that it is wrong. In the time of their pain you can ache for them and with them. But you cannot leave it there.
    - b. You can then turn the corner in the conversation by asking a simple question: "Can you tell me your thoughts on why it is like this and

your solution to it all?" And let them talk. Hear them. And then propose that they consider what the bible says.

J. The problem is due to sin. It is that simple. And today I want to show you the root of sin, the depth of sin, the extent of sin and the result of sin. The root, depth, extent and result of sin.

- II. We need to be saved because of the problem of sin.
  - A. The root of sin.
    - 1. Genesis 1:1.

2. Romans 5:12 with Genesis 3:1-7.

- 3. So this is the **root**, the first man chose rebellion over his Creator and God and sin, death and all other things evil and twisted became the norm.
- B. The depth of sin.
  - 1. Here the question we ask is how deep does sin go?

- 2. The bible is very clear on this issue—sin affects all aspects of a person. There is no part of you or I that is unmarred by sin.
- 3. Let's see this in a couple of passages.
  - a. Mark 7:20-23.

- b. Jeremiah 17:9-10.
- 4. So we see in just a couple of passages that the bible declares that sin goes deep into the very core of what makes you human. Your heart is sinful and in rebellion to God. But what about the **extent** of this sin. Yes it is present in the depths of my heart, but to what **extent** does it affect me?
- C. The extent of sin.
  - 1. We can stay in Jeremiah 17 for this as well for it then states the extent of this heart problem.

- 2. Genesis 6:5.
  - a. External.

b. Internal.

- 3. And all the rest of the bible simply takes this absolute statement and enlarges upon it and illustrates it. Never once does it make it go away or lessen it. This is the **extent** of sin.
- D. The result of sin.
  - 1. Romans 1:18-32.


2. Romans 2:1-5.

### III. Conclusion.

- A. Today we considered in brief what the bible teaches about humanity. Though brief, it is seen to be a thread that runs through the scripture from the beginning to the end.
- B. To not grasp sin and our broken relationship with our Creator is to step onto a road that leads to so many errors.
- C. I submit to you that a robust understanding of sin, or the fall of mankind, gives the best explanation for why things are the way they are.
  - 1. But it cannot give us hope. If these things are true, if each of us in a sinner, going our own way, rejecting both passively and actively, our Maker, then what is needed to be right with God?
  - 2. And this is what we will see next week in the person and work of Jesus Christ.
  - 3. We will lay Jesus Christ upon the backdrop of what we learned today and see how He is truly the Way of rescue and deliverance from our sin. And that He is the only way.


