
DAY 6

DAY 1

But you belong to God, my dear children. You have already won a victory over those people, because the Spirit who lives in you is greater than the spirit who lives in the world. 1 John 4:4 NLT

When you know someone is looking out for you and has your back, it gives you confidence you might not otherwise have. Why? Because it is always easier to face tough situations knowing you're not alone. The best news is, because of Jesus, we are not alone when we face difficult situations or feel negative emotions. We can be bold because Jesus is has our back.

This confidence comes from knowing that Jesus is greater, stronger, and more loving than anything else in the world and all that strength, power and love is in your corner, cheering you on.

DAY 2

This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go. Joshua 1:9 NLT

Not knowing how things will play out, and being unsure of what to do next can lead us to feeling scared, frustrated, and doubtful. There are a million questions and possibilities, and the uncertainty is often scarier than the actual situation. This verse reminds us that we aren't alone when we face the unknown. That doesn't mean what we are facing isn't scary. But it does mean our circumstances don't have to overwhelm us, because Jesus has promised us His presence.

In other words, the emotions of fear and doubt are overpowered by the confidence we have that God is with us wherever we go.

DAY 3

I know the Lord is always with me. I will not be shaken, for he is right beside me. Psalm 16:8 NLT

It is hard to find words to say or know what to do in moments that leave our friends and family shaken. We don't want to say, or do, the wrong thing. Sometimes, the best thing you can do is just show up and be present. The things that can leave us shaken, usually make us feel pretty alone and isolated, and it is good to simply know that someone is with us in hard moments. DAY 4

And that even in knowing that, God has always been crazy about you, accepting of you, and never once reconsidered the love he has shown to you.

Thanks to Jesus, we know God doesn't leave us to figure out our messes, but comes right alongside us and helps us to know we are not alone.


DAY 5
