WHEN I KNOW <u>WHO</u> I AM I'LL KNOW <u>WHAT</u> TO DO

I AM HIS <u>SALT</u> AND <u>LIGHT!</u>

"You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled by men." Matthew 5:13

What does salt do?

- Salt <u>preserves</u>.
 As His salt, we preserve the Truth of God in a culture of moral relevance.
- Salt <u>purifies</u>.
 As His salt, we bring the purity of Christ to a culture of immorality.
- Salt creates thirst.
 As His salt, we create a thirst in people for the things of God.
- Salt melts.
 As His salt, our love softens the hardness of man's heart so they can experience God.
- Salt <u>heals</u>.
 As His salt, we administer the healing power of God to the broken-hearted and outcasts of this world.

"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. 15Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. 16In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven." Matthew 5:14-16

Since I am His light...

• I let my <u>light shine</u>.

About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them. Acts 16:25

Suddenly there was such a violent earthquake that the foundations of the prison were shaken. At once all the prison doors flew open, and everybody's chains came loose. The jailer woke up, and when he saw the prison doors open, he drew his sword and was about to kill himself because he thought the prisoners had escaped. But Paul shouted, "Don't harm yourself! We are all here!" Acts 16:26-28

- I light up dark places.
- I point people to <u>Jesus</u>.

The jailer called for lights, rushed in and fell trembling before Paul and Silas. He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved — you and your household." Acts 16:29-31
