Food for Growth

Matthew 4:4

And this is the word that was preached to you. (NIV)

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF GOD'S WORD

God's Word Endures Forever

Matthew 24:35

Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

God's Word Gives Life

1 Peter 1:23

For *you have been born again*, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, *through the living* and enduring *word of God*.

The Word of God has life giving power.

Hebrews 4:12 (NIV)

For the word of God is *living and active*. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

John 6:63 (NIV)

The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you are spirit and *they are life*.

When we, by faith, receive the Word of God and obey it, we experience true life!

God's Word Cleanses

1 Peter 1:22-25

Now that you have purified yourselves by obeying the truth

John 17:17

Make them holy by your truth; teach them your word, which is truth. (NLT)

THE NOURISHMENT OF GOD'S WORD

1 Peter 2:1-3 (NLT)

So get rid of all evil behavior. Be done with all deceit, hypocrisy, jealousy, and all unkind speech. 2 Like newborn babies, you must crave pure spiritual milk so that you will **grow** into a full experience of salvation. Cry out for this **nourishment**, now that you have had a taste of the Lord's kindness.

THE INHIBITOR OF GOD'S WORD

1 Peter 2:1

So get rid of all evil behavior. Be done with all deceit, hypocrisy, jealousy, and all unkind speech.

The greatest inhibitor of God's Word is **sin**.

God's Word will keep you from **sin** and **sin** will keep you from God's Word.

THE HUNGER FOR GOD'S WORD

1 Peter 2:2-3

Like newborn babies, you must *crave* pure spiritual milk so that you will grow into a full experience of salvation. *Cry out for this nourishment*, 3 now that you have had a taste of the Lord's kindness. (NLT)

Babies have an intense and prolonged **desire** for milk, and they let you know it.

As we crave, hunger, and take in God's Word, He grows us increasingly into His image.

DEVELOPING A HUNGER FOR GOD'S WORD

Some practical suggestions:

• Ask the Lord to make you hungry.
