Five Statements on Doubt...

- 1. Doubt is natural.
- 2. Doubt is not the enemy of faith.
- 3. Doubt is distinct from unbelief.
- 4. Doubt is able to overtake anyone at any time.
- 5. Doubt is no match for the patient love of Jesus.



BIG Idea: Instead of hiding your doubts, let Jesus handle your doubts.

A Case Study On Doubt...



1. Even the G.O.A.T., John the Baptist, had doubts about Jesus (Matt. 11:1-3 & 11a).

2. Jesus isn't offended by John's doubts, but instead reassures John by anchoring his doubts (Matt. 11:4-6).

A Case Study On Doubt...

3. Jesus makes it clear that John's doubts do not invalidate his great status as a messenger (Matt. 11:7-15).

4. Jesus rebukes those who do more than doubt, they disbelieve (Matt. 11:16-19).
