AND HARD-HEARTEDNESS...

MATTHEW 16:1-12

Hostile Intent (Matt. 16:1)

- “The Pharisees *and Sadducees* came...to test Him...”
- “The Pharisees...” VS “The Sadducees...”
- “They asked him to show them a sign *from heaven*...”

QUESTION: Does Jesus have to personally prove himself to you before you believe?

Honest Indictment (Matt. 16:2-4)

- “You know how to interpret the appearance of the sky, but you cannot interpret the signs of the times...”
- “The Signs Of The Times...”
- “The Sign of Jonah...”

QUESTION: Are you more in tune with the weather, the stock market, or the latest fashion trend than the signs of the times?

Hard-Hearted Ignorance (Matt. 16:5-12)

- “They had forgotten to bring bread...”
- “Watch and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees...”
- “Little faith...”

QUESTION: Is God using a physical problem in your life to teach you a spiritual lesson?
