After You've Asked Your Questions...

1. Wait on the Lord (Habakkuk 2:1)

- **Definition** – Watching for God, despite difficulty or distress, without getting overly scared, snarky, or sad.
- **How should we wait on the Lord?**
 - Eagerly (Habakkuk 2:1a).
 - Thoughtfully (Habakkuk 2:1b).
- **Why should we wait on the Lord?**
 - There's a **BLESSING** for those who wait (Isaiah 30:18).
 - There's **STRENGTHENING** for those who wait (Isaiah 40:30-31).

2. Trust in the Lord (Habakkuk 2:4)

- **Definition** – Relying on God for our salvation from sin and our sustainment through struggles.
- **How should we trust in the Lord?**
 - We trust in God's plan (Habakkuk 2:2).
 - We trust in God's timing (Habakkuk 2:3).
- **Why should we trust in the Lord?**
 - There's only two types of people: Righteous vs Unrighteous (Habakkuk 2:4-5)...
 - There's only two ways to live: Faith vs Pride!

3. **Worship before the Lord (Habakkuk 2:20)**
 - **Definition** – Recognizing the worth and wonder of the one true God.
 - **How should we worship the Lord?**
 - In silence (Habakkuk 2:20).
 - In awe (Habakkuk 1:5).
 - **Why should we worship the Lord?**
 - Because of what He will do (Habakkuk 2:6-19).
 - Because of who He is (Habakkuk 2:14, 20).
