

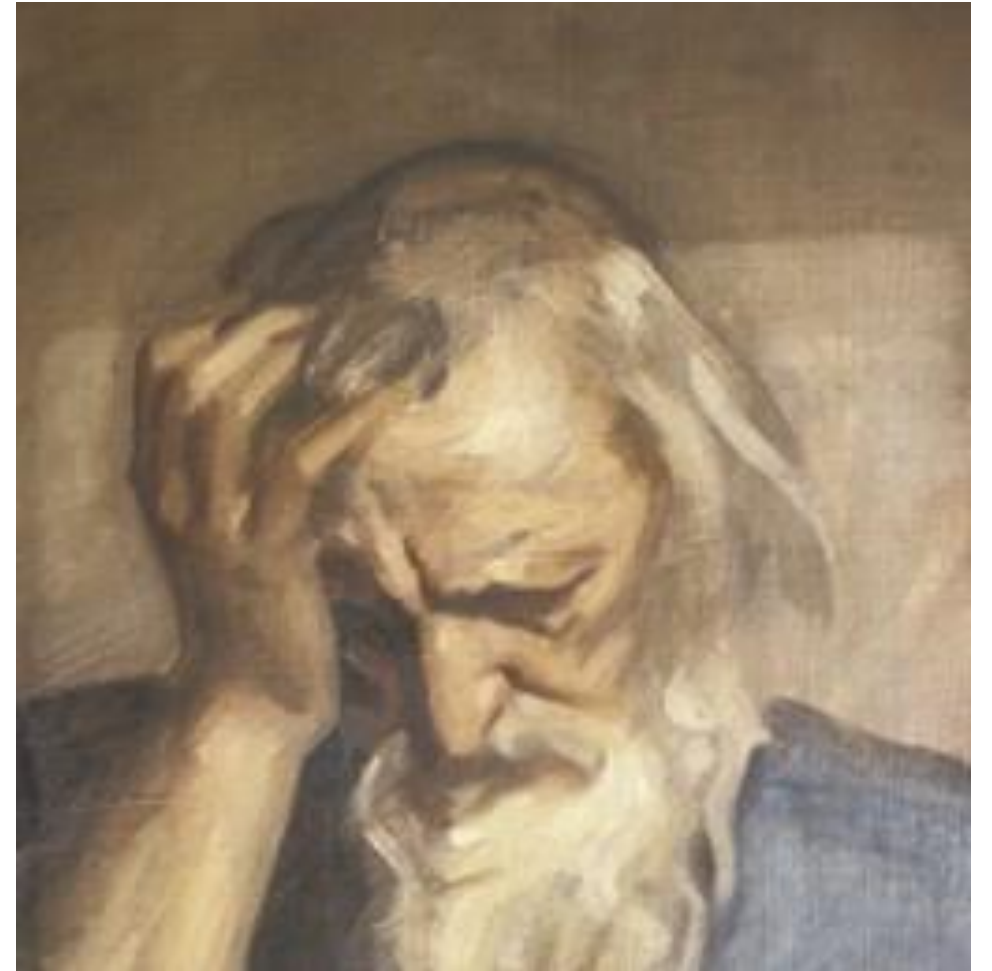


What do you do when what you see with your eyes

Learning From Habakkuk's Questions...

1. Godly people struggle with their godless culture.
2. Godly people struggle with God in relation to their culture.
3. Godly people struggle with faith in God and doubts about God.





Learning From God's Answers...

1. God isn't troubled by our godless culture.
2. God isn't intimidated by our questions about our culture.
3. God isn't shocked by our small faith or our growing doubts.

Learning From Habakkuk's Second Round of Questions...

1. Pain causes us to cry out for justice and mercy.
2. Pain forces us to examine the full character of God.
3. Pain (no matter how intense) has a purpose.
