Why are we so slow to learn?


- 1. We think knowing and doing are the same thing.
- 2. We don't like to be told what to do.
- 3. We would rather learn from multiple failed experiences than follow a step-by-step plan.



Rerun: Jesus is able to meet our every need & satisfy the deepest longings of our soul.

Question: How many times does Jesus need to show up in your life, meeting your needs and protecting you from harm, for you to really trust Him?

- 1. Yes, the <u>past provision</u> of Jesus proves it (Matt. 14:13-21)...
 - ❖ Jesus is more than a good teacher and a miracle worker; He is the Son of God!
 - Jesus is not limited by our resources!
 - Jesus didn't merely come to give bread, but to be the Bread!



- 2. Yes, the constant compassion of Jesus proves it (Matt. 15:32)...
 - * Compassion consistently moved Jesus towards action.
 - Compassion counterculturally moved Jesus towards Jews & Gentiles.
 - Compassion should move us towards loving action on behalf of others.



- 3. Yes, the <u>never-ending power</u> of Jesus proves it (Matt. 15:33-36)...
 - The power of Jesus does not have a finish line in this life or the life to come.
 - The power of Jesus is belittled in our lives when we only see the problems in our lives.
 - *The power of Jesus motivates us to trust Jesus when new problems erupt in our lives.

- 4. Yes, the <u>plentiful leftovers</u> of Jesus prove it (Matt. 15:37-39)...
 - Our circumstances may change, but Jesus' compassion never does.
 - Our circumstances may change, but Jesus' power never does.
 - Our circumstances may change, but Jesus' grace never does.
