



Use this guide to help your community group engage further with this week's sermon.

Persevere In Your Faith! (Hebrews 10:32-39)

March 8, 2026

Read Hebrews 10:32-39 and discuss these questions.

1. When you think about the early days of your faith in Christ, what challenges or opposition did you experience? How did God sustain you through those times?
2. The believers mentioned in Hebrews endured suffering with joy because of what they knew they could not lose (Heb. 10:32-34). What suffering and opposition might we experience because of faith in Christ? What eternal realities help anchor our joy today?
3. What does "confidence" (Heb. 10:35) in Christ look like in everyday life? What can threaten to cause us to throw it away?
4. How can we help one another endure in our faith? Where are you currently being called to endure rather than give up or shrink back?
5. "Shrinking back" (Heb. 10:38) from faith in Christ is often subtle and quiet: less prayer and Bible meditation, less corporate worship, less seeking repentance, less embracing Christian community, etc. Which of these (or others) do you need to guard against right now?
6. What's one specific way you can stay near and trust God, even if answers and relief from suffering seem delayed?

Pray for one another according to this passage:

- How would you like us to pray for you in light of this conversation?
- Ask for enduring faith in present struggles.
- Pray for confidence that is not thrown away.
- Thank God for joy that is rooted in eternal hope.
