## **Finish in Faith: Exalt Him Together**

**February 15, 2026**

**Read Matthew 28:16-20, Romans 12:1-2, and Psalm 34:3 and discuss these questions:**

1. What is worship? How does worshipping God shape all aspects of our lives, like work, rest, fellowship, recreation, etc.?
2. Worship involves our mind, heart, and will. Why is it important to remember this? How might we pursue a new facility in a way that reflects hearts, minds, and wills that are truly set on exalting Christ, not just on having a nicer space?
3. What's at stake if we view worship as merely an individual matter? When have you benefited from worshipping with others?
4. What can hinder us from exalting God? What opportunities do we have at Living Gospel Church to exalt Him? How can a new facility help us exalt Him together?
5. How can we practice worshipping God for who He is, not just what He does? Why should we care about this distinction?
6. How can giving of our time, talents, and treasures cultivate a culture of worshipping God in our generation and the next?

**Pray for one another according to this passage:** How would you like us to pray for you in light of this passage and conversation?

- In this season, ask God to capture your heart again so that Christ is your first love and highest joy.
