

Use this guide to help your community group engage further with this week's sermon.

Church: A Community of Communities (1 Corinthians 12:12-27) September 1, 2024

- 1. What has led to a positive and/or negative experience of community in your life?
- Look through Genesis 1-3 and discuss these questions about *God's design* for community and *sin's effect* on it:
 - a. What leads God to say, "it is good" and "it is not good"?
 - b. What does Adam discover after God gives him the task of naming the animals?
 - c. With whom did God create humans to have relationships and community?
 - d. How does sin affect the ability to commune in these relationships?
- 3. Look through 1 Corinthians 12:12-27 and discuss *Jesus' vision for community* among His followers:
 - a. What image does Paul use to describe the church?
 - b. Who is the church meant to *unify* around? What happens when we don't? (vv. 12-13; *also* Eph. 1:22-23; Col. 1:18)?
 - c. What's the danger in believing "everyone should be like me"?
 - d. How could God use *diverse* gifts, perspectives, and preferences to strengthen our church?
- 4. Discuss how God is using His Word to transform your life right now.
 - a. Should you be *dependent* on others in our church or independent? Explain.
 - b. How does your life demonstrate a "you don't need me" and/or "I don't need you" mentality in our church community? What experiences are behind this?
 - c. How does this passage make you thankful for God's grace through Christ?
 - d. By God's grace, what's one step you can take into deeper community at LGC?
 - e. In light of what we've discussed, how would you like our group to pray for you?
