Parent Letter - Rise Youth

Dear Parents,

We are excited to begin another year with Rise Youth! Our goal is to keep you connected, encouraged, and equipped as you walk alongside your students. Here are a few important things we want you to know:

What We're Studying

This fall, Rise Youth will be studying 1–2 Kings, tracing the story of God's people from the reign of Solomon, David's son, through generations of kings, all the way to the exile. These books don't shy away from showing us the reality of leadership gone wrong—most of the kings were unfaithful and led the people deeper into idolatry and sin.

But even during this decline, we see something greater: God's promises never fail. He had promised to send a Messiah, and nothing—not bad kings, not exile, not rebellion—could stop His plan.

The point of 1–2 Kings isn't simply to show us failure, but to point us to the one true King: Jesus Christ. From the very beginning, He was the one rescuing His people, and He is still faithful today. 1-2 Kings is so applicable to us today because in it we see that God's Word can be trusted and that He is faithful to His promises. So, trust Jesus, the promised King who crushed the head of Satan and reigns forever!

As students see God's faithfulness in the past, our prayer is that they will also see the hope we have in Him today—a hope that goes beyond the grave. This is the good news we long for them not only to believe deeply, but also to share boldly with others. We want to see our students foster a heart for evangelism, recognizing that because Jesus is faithful, His promises are sure, and His salvation is worth proclaiming.

Each week, students will be encouraged to read the passage ahead of time and come prepared to discuss it in their small groups. We invite you as parents to encourage them to stay engaged with the study at home—and even read alongside them if you'd like!

Our Small Group Leaders

One of the greatest strengths of Rise Youth is our team of dedicated small group leaders. Pastor Peter deeply values these leaders—not only for their love for students but also for their faithfulness to walk alongside them in discipleship.

Students are placed in small groups very intentionally. Peter prays over these decisions and carefully considers both the students and the leaders, wanting every student to be in a group where they will be known, encouraged, and challenged to grow in Christ.

Once your profile is set up in the app, go to your profile, scroll down to Notifications, and "turn on" Rise Youth Push Notifications. These will show up in your inbox within the app and allow us to communicate more effectively with you.
- 3. **Rise Youth Messaging Group** Join the conversation within the app to stay connected with other families. This is a place where parents and students can ask questions about youth events, the lessons, theology, parenting, really anything youth ministry related!
