## Joy in Gospel Advance (Philippians 1:12-18) April 7, 2024

- 1. Paul found joy in the fact that the gospel advanced in three unique situations. Can you identify these situations from Philippians 1:13, 14, and 15-18?
- 2. Paul's ability to see the bigger picture despite his circumstances, as described in Romans 1:14-17, can serve as a powerful example for us. How can his perspective encourage you to see the bigger picture of what God is doing in your life, even in challenging times?
- 3. In what ways has God used unexpected means to accomplish gospel advance in your life?
- 4. How have you seen Christians proclaiming Christ for the wrong reasons?
  - a. What were their motives?
  - b. "Paul could only celebrate the success of their preaching if they were truly preaching Christ." Discuss situations in which we shouldn't celebrate the preaching of others.
- 5. How can we, like Paul, be joyful in all circumstances? Discuss how Paul's reasons for joy could impact your own joy this week:
  - a. Christians are saints (Phil. 1:1).
  - b. Christians are slaves of Christ (Phil. 1:1).
  - c. Christians are partners in the gospel (Phil. 1:5).
  - d. Christians are good works in God's hands (Phil. 1:6).
  - e. The gospel advances, even in unexpected places (Phil. 1:18).
