Questions

- 1. What's the important lesson we see in Joshua 9:14? Today we have access to nearly endless amounts of information. Does that ever hinder your dependence on the Lord's wisdom and help?
- 2. Leaders that God has called are still just men. Like all believers, they are subject to temptation and the effects of remaining sin. Are they any insights to glean from the Gibeonite story to help you in following and praying for your elders?
- 3. What does God tell His people about vows and commitments we make?
- 4. Read Joshua 9:26-27. In what ways are we seeing God's grace at work?
- 5. Read Joshua 10:1-5. What can we learn about the rebellion of the Canaanite nations? How does it confirm God's judgment of these nations?
- 6. Read Deuteronomy 10:8. In stressful or uncertain situations, how important is it for us to be reminded of promises God has already made and victories He's already won? Why? And how do you remind yourself of such things?
- 7. Read Psalm 15:1-4. In what ways are you most challenged to show integrity with people outside of the body of Christ? How can you strive to grow in this area?
