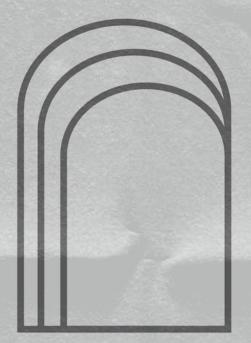
FASTING IS DONE FOR A SPIRITUAL PURPOSE

Biblical fasting is not done for health reasons or for personal evaluation; biblical fasting is striclty spiritual purposes. The bible declares that Jesus is the bread of life and whoever comes to him will never go hungry. Not physically hungry but spiritually. The same desire for food we experience in fasting is the desire we should feel for the Bread of Life when we experience spiritual hunger. (John 6:35)

FASTING WITH HUMILITY

Fasting humbles ourselves before the Lord. The bible tells us that they fasted humbly, prayed fiercely and God answered. (Ezra 8:21-23)

THE GOAL OF FASTING?

HOW SHOULD WE FAST?

The bible tells us that when we fast we should not look gloomy. We shouldn't be fasting to gain acknowledgment from man but instead we fast in secret because Matthew tells us that fasting done in secret will be rewarded by God. Fast with humility and joy. (Matthew 6:16-18)

BEYOND BEAUTIFUL

FASTING DENIES THE FLESH

Paul states that we are ruled by our stomachs, implying we are ruled by the flesh and if we are being ruled by the flesh we're not giving glory to God. Fasting denies the flesh and allows us to glorify God. (Philippians 3:19)

FASTING GIVES US SPIRITUAL FREEDOM
