Horsemanship
General Horsemanship meets at your experience level to challenge and develop your riding skills, and overall horsemanship abilities.

Campers In Training
CIT's are high school aged campers who spend three weeks being challenged with unique Bible studies, helping camp with work projects, participating in fun camp activities, and going on a mission's trip. The CIT II program is for campers who have completed CIT I (only offered session 2: Weeks 4 - 6). The CIT III program is for those who have completed CIT I & II. These campers stay all summer for free, work 6-7 hours a day, and have more in-depth Bible Studies.

CHECK IN: Sunday 3-5 P.M.
DEPARTURE: Come for a FREE lunch with your camper on Friday from 11:45 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. Video of the week and closing session at 1:15 P.M.
RULES: As a Christian-based camp, it must be clear that all registered campers will attend camp services and will participate in the regular program. No tobacco, alcohol, vape, or drugs are allowed. There is to be no public display of affection. No bikinis or midriffs are allowed at the swimming pool. Tankinis with full coverage are acceptable. For everyday wear, please err on the side of modesty.
CAMPER CALLS: Campers will not be allowed to use the phone except on the weekends. In case of emergency, the administration will contact you. You may send emails to your camper. Please put camper's name on the subject line.

SPENDING MONEY: Average campers spend \$40 per week (plus tee shirt). Money brought to camp will be deposited in the camper bank. The Snak Shak, which also includes t-shirts and souvenirs, is open twice a day. Crafts, riflery, & paintball have minimal charges as well (at least \$40 extra for paintball).
WHAT TO BRING: Sleeping bags, casual modest clothes, bathing suit (girls—modest one piece or tankini), jacket, flashlight, Bible, towels, toiletries, and spending money. Please mark all articles with your name. Our lost and found department has a two-week maximum holding time on articles.
PLEASE DO NOT BRING: TV's, cell phones, computers, electronic games, weapons, knives, CD, DVD, MP3, MP4, iPod, fireworks, tobacco, alcohol, vape, or illegal drugs.
