Word of the Year: Partners of Promise

Verse of the Year: Whenever I pray, I make my requests for all of you with joy, for you have been my partners in spreading the Good News about Christ from the time you first heard it until now. **Philippians 1:4-5 (NLT)**

Deuteronomy 5:12 (NIV) Observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy, as the Lord your God has commanded you.

Luke 13:10-21 (ISV)

Romans 14:5-6 (TPT) In the same way, one person regards a certain day as more sacred than another, and another person regards them all alike. There is nothing wrong with having different personal convictions about such matters. For the person who observes one day as especially sacred does it to honor the Lord. And the same is true regarding what a person eats.
