**Word of the Year:** Partners of Promise

**Verse of the Year:** Whenever I pray, I make my requests for all of you with joy, for you have been my partners in spreading the Good News about Christ from the time you first heard it until now. **Philippians 1:4-5 (NLT)**

Deuteronomy 5:17-18 (NIV) You must not murder. You must not commit adultery.

God said it - enough said - but is it - Jesus says:

Matthew 5:21-22 (NIV) "You have heard that our ancestors were told, 'You must not murder. If you commit murder you are subject to judgment.' But I say, if you are even angry with someone, you are subject to judgment!"

Matthew 5:27-28 (NIV) "You have heard the commandment that says, 'You must not commit adultery.' But I say, anyone who even looks at a woman with lust has already committed adultery with her in his heart."

Simple! Because \_\_\_\_\_ starts in the mind!

Progression of sin described in 1 John 1

Lie to \_\_\_\_\_. 1 John 1:6 (NIV) If we claim to have fellowship with him yet walk in darkness, we lie and do not live in the truth.

Lie to \_\_\_\_\_. 1 John 1:8 (NIV) If we claim to be without sin we deceive ourselves.

Lie to \_\_\_\_\_. 1 John 1:10 (NIV) If we claim we have not sinned we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.

Exercise for your mind - 2 Corinthians 10:5 (NIV)

We take captive every thought and make it obedient to Christ.

Recognize thoughts that are not \_\_\_\_\_. *Philippians 4:8*

If they're not from God \_\_\_\_\_ out at once!
