Word of the Year: Partners of Promise

Deuteronomy 5:21 (NIV) You shall not covet.

Covet: Means to desire or lust. It is not the wanting of something that is wrong, but wanting it at the expense of others or from a motive of jealousy or envy.

Temptation brings coveting. (Genesis 3:1-6)
Coveting brings sin. (Genesis 3:7-12)
Sin brings death. (James 1:13-14)
Death brings the need for a Savior. (Matthew 22:37-40)
God and love upon this hangs all the law and the prophets.
