 - o 171 of the 176 verses speak to the Word of God.
- Alphabetic Acrostic: Each stanza has 8
 verses and every verse of that stanza
 begins with the same letter of the Hebrew
 alphabet.
 - o 22 stanzas correspond to 22 letters in Hebrew alphabet
