- **Longest** psalm and chapter in the bible (176 verses)
- Theme: The greatness of **God's Word**
 - 171 of the 176 verses speak to the Word of God.
- **Alphabetic Acrostic:** Each stanza has 8 verses and every verse of that stanza begins with the same letter of the Hebrew alphabet.
 - 22 stanzas correspond to 22 letters in Hebrew alphabet
