- Written by Moses towards the end of his life.
- “Deuteronomy” comes from Greek Word *deuternomion* = “second law.”
- Theme: a renewal of the people’s obedience to God’s Law.

Deuteronomy 6:4-9

Parents are the primary disciple-makers
of their children.

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1. You cannot take someone somewhere where
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“Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

6 And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart.”

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2. Make every moment a gospel moment. (v. 7)



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Deuteronomy 6:4-9

1. You cannot take someone somewhere where you've never been. (vv. 4-6)
 2. Make every moment a gospel moment. (v. 7)
- 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.”*

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3. Keep God's Word at the center of daily living (vv. 8-9)

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“8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.”



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
