

The Sons of Korah

- Korah was a <u>Levite</u> who led a rebellion against Moses in the wilderness.
- "Gatekeeper" <u>Security Guard/Bouncer</u> for the Temple



- God's Presence in the Temple Blesses His People (vs. 1-4)
 - Old Testament Picture:
 - The Psalmist longs to experience the special presence of God in the <u>Temple</u>.

- God's Presence in the Temple Blesses His People (vs. 1-4)
 - New Testament Reality:
 - God's people are the temple individually and corporately.

- God's Presence in the Temple Blesses His People (vs. 1-4)
 - New Testament Reality:
 - We should <u>desire</u> God's presence through His indwelling Holy Spirit.



- God's Presence in the Journey Sustains His People (vs. 5-10)
 - Old Testament Picture:
 - As the Israelites traveled through desert valleys, the hope of God's presence in the Temple <u>sustained</u> them.

- God's Presence in the Journey Sustains His People (vs. 5-10)
 - New Testament Reality:
 - The joy of experiencing the fullness of the presence of God in eternity makes the difficult journey worthwhile.



- God's King Brings God's Presence to His People (vs. 11-12)
 - Old Testament Picture:
 - God provided for and protected His people through His anointed king.



- God's King Brings God's Presence to His People (vs. 11-12)
 - New Testament Reality:
 - Through the work of <u>Jesus</u> on the cross, we can experience the presence of God.
