Day 12: More To Come

Philippians 2:7 "...he made himself nothing by taking on the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness...

Jesus's birth reminds us of another important truth. The Apostle Paul writes this passage in Philippians 2 that touches on the eternality of Christ and how he left the realm of heaven to come to here.
