







## The Giftings of the Holy Spirit, pt. 1

**1Co 12:1-3** Now concerning spiritual *gifts*, brethren, I do not want you to be ignorant: You know that you were Gentiles, carried away to these dumb idols, however you were led. Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God calls Jesus accursed, and no one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit.

**1Co 12:4** There are **diversities of gifts**, but the same Spirit.

**1Co 12:5** There are **differences of ministries**, but the same Lord.

**1Co 12:6** And there are **diversities of activities**, but it is the same God who works all in all.

**1Co 12:7** **But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:**

**1Co 12:8** for to one is given **the word of wisdom** through the Spirit, to another **the word of knowledge** through the same Spirit,

**1Co 12:9** to another **faith** by the same Spirit, to another **gifts of healings** by the same Spirit,

**1Co 12:10** to another the **working of miracles**, to another **prophecy**, to another **discerning of spirits**, to another **different kinds of tongues**, to another **the interpretation of tongues**.

**1Co 12:11** **But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.**

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**1Co 12:7** **But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:**

**Gifts:** charisma – to show favor, a gift of grace (Grace Gifts)

**Ministries:** diakonia – from which we get the word “deacon”, to serve, service, ministry, support, attend to, a servant

**Diversities/differences:** varieties, distinctions, differences

**Manifestation:** Clear, outward display, to make visible or observable to others

## The Giftings of the Holy Spirit, pt. 1

### One Body with Many Members

1Co 12:12 For as the **body is one** and has many **members**, but all the **members** of that **one body**, being many, are **one body**, so also *is* Christ.

1Co 12:13 For by **one Spirit** we were all baptized into **one body**—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into **one Spirit**.

1Co 12:14 For in fact the **body** is not one **member** but many.

1Co 12:15 If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I am not of the **body**," is it therefore not of the **body**?

1Co 12:16 And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I am not of the **body**," is it therefore not of the **body**?

1Co 12:17 If the whole **body** *were* an eye, where *would be* the hearing? If the whole *were* hearing, where *would be* the smelling?

1Co 12:18 But now **God** has set the **members**, each one of them, in the **body** just as **He** pleased.

1Co 12:19 And if they *were* all one **member**, where *would* the **body** *be*?

## The Giftings of the Holy Spirit, pt. 1

**1Co 12:20** But now indeed *there are* many **members**, yet **one body**.

**1Co 12:21** And the eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you"; nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you."

**1Co 12:22** No, much rather, those **members** of the **body** which seem to be weaker are necessary.

**1Co 12:23** And those **members** of the **body** which we think to be less honorable, on these we bestow greater honor; and our unpresentable *parts* have greater modesty,

**1Co 12:24** but our presentable *parts* have no need. But God composed the **body**, having given greater honor to that *part* which lacks it,

**1Co 12:25** that there should be no schism in the **body**, but *that* the **members** should have the same care for **one another**. (**schism** – division, split, parties, dissensions, tearing)

**1Co 12:26** And if one **member** suffers, all the **members** suffer with *it*; or if one **member** is honored, all the **members** rejoice with *it*.

**1Co 12:27** Now you are the **body of Christ**, and **members** individually.

**1Co 12:8** for to one is given **the word of wisdom** through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit

- **Word of Wisdom** – to be given wisdom supernaturally (revealed) as/when needed
  - 1 Kings 3 - King Solomon with the two mothers
  - Acts 6 - the Hellenistic Jews
  - Acts 15 – Legalistic Jews –vs- Gentiles
  - **Psa 111:10** The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom; A good understanding have all those who do *His commandments*. His praise endures forever.
  - **Pro 2:6** For the LORD gives wisdom; From His mouth *come* knowledge and understanding;
  - **Pro 3:13** Happy *is* the man *who* finds wisdom, And the man *who* gains understanding;
  - **Pro 3:14** For her proceeds *are* better than the profits of silver, And her gain than fine gold.
  - **2Ch 1:10** Now give me wisdom and knowledge, that I may go out and come in before this people; for who can judge this great people of Yours?"

**1Co 12:8** for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another **the word of knowledge** through the same Spirit

- **Word of Knowledge** - to be given knowledge supernaturally (revealed) as/when needed
  - **Pro 1:7** The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge, *But* fools despise wisdom and instruction.
  - 2 Kings 6 - Elisha the prophet and King of Syria— God revealed to him the inner workings
  - John 4 – Jesus and the woman at the well
  - Acts 5 – Ananias & Saphira
  - Acts 8 – Peter and Simon, the sorcerer

## The Giftings of the Holy Spirit, pt. 1

**1Co 12:9** to another **faith** by the same Spirit, to another **gifts of healings** by the same Spirit

- **Faith** – the ability to believe God for something either in the moment or forever, to trust God against circumstances
  - Peter, walking out on the water to meet Jesus
  - Peter, Acts 3, healing the beggar by the gate
  - Jesus, feeding the 5000
  - George Mueller – feeding the orphans in England
- **Gifts of Healings** – the divine, God-given ability to heal in the moment, either given or received (notice the plurality)
  - Clarke on **gifts of healings**: “the power which at particular times the apostles received from the Holy Spirit to cure diseases; a power which was not always resident in them; for Paul could not cure Timothy, nor remove his own thorn in the flesh; because it was given only on extraordinary occasions, though perhaps more *generally* than many others.”
  - Again, Peter in Acts 3
  - Jesus – multiple time thru the Gospels
  - Acts 20- Paul, healing the man who fell out the window

**1Co 12:10** to another the **working of miracles**, to another **prophecy**, to another **discerning of spirits**, to another ***different* kinds of tongues**, to another **the interpretation of tongues**.

- **Working of Miracles** – **dunamis** – acts of power
  - Elijah and the prophets of Baal – 1 Kings 18
  - Jesus – many times
  - The Apostles – many times
- **Prophecy** – both predictive (fore-telling) and proclaiming (with conviction)
- **Discerning of spirits** – separation, distinction, removing doubt
  - **1Jn 4:1** Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God; because many false prophets have gone out into the world.
- **Different kinds of tongues** –
  - The ability to speak in a known language, unknown to the speaker
  - The ability to speak to God directly in a spiritual language (1 Cor 14)
- **Interpretation of tongues** – divine ability to interpret tongues/languages

**1Co 12:11** **But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.**

**1Co 12:28** **And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues.**

**1Co 12:29** *Are all apostles? Are all prophets? Are all teachers? Are all workers of miracles?*

**1Co 12:30** **Do all have gifts of healings? Do all speak with tongues? Do all interpret?**

**1Co 12:31** **But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet I show you a more excellent way.**

**Luk 11:13** If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more will *your* heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"**
