







The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Jesus's teaching the Lord's Prayer

Luk 11:9-13 "So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened. If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if *he asks* for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!**"

Jas 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Joh 14:15-17 "If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.

- With you = para – alongside you
- In you = en – inside you

Joh 14:26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Joh 15:26-27 "But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, ***He will testify of Me.*** And you **also** will bear witness, because you have been with Me from the beginning.

Joh 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.

Joh 16:13-14 However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, ***He will guide you into all truth;*** for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. ***He will glorify Me,*** for He will take of what is Mine and declare *it* to you.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Joh 20:20-22 When He had said this, He showed them *His* hands and His side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you." And when He had said this, He breathed on *them*, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit..."

- The disciples receive the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit, the baptism of the Spirit would come later at Pentecost...

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Mat 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. **He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.**

- **Baptize = to cover wholly, immerse, submerge, make wet, saturate, wash, bathe, to overwhelm**
 - Passive voice, Jesus does this to/for us

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Luk 24:45-49 And He opened their understanding, that they might comprehend the Scriptures. Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. And you are witnesses of these things. Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high."

- Endued – clothed (passive voice)

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 1:4-5 And being assembled together with *them*, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," *He said*, "you have heard from Me; for John truly baptized with water, **but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.**"

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 1:6-8 Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

- Upon you - 'epi – Strongs - A primary preposition properly meaning *superimposition*... that is, *over, upon...of rest*
 - Zhodiates = rest upon
- Power to be His witnesses

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

The Coming of the Spirit on Pentecost

Act 2:1 When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

Act 2:2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting.

Act 2:3 Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them.

Act 2:4 And they were all **filled** with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. (**filled** – wholly imbued [dip, drench, steep], influenced, affected, fully supplied)

Act 2:5 And there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men, from every nation under heaven.

Act 2:6 And when this sound occurred, the multitude came together, and were confused, because everyone heard them speak in his own language.

Act 2:7 Then they were all amazed and marveled, saying to one another, "Look, are not all these who speak Galileans?"

Act 2:8 And how is it that we hear, each in our own language in which we were born?

Act 2:9 Parthians and Medes and Elamites, those dwelling in Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia,

Act 2:10 Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya adjoining Cyrene, visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes,

Act 2:11 Cretans and Arabs—we hear them speaking in our own tongues the wonderful works of God."

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Peter's Sermon at Pentecost

Act 2:17 'AND IT SHALL COME TO PASS IN THE LAST DAYS, SAYS GOD, THAT I WILL POUR OUT OF MY SPIRIT ON ALL FLESH; YOUR SONS AND YOUR DAUGHTERS SHALL PROPHESY, YOUR YOUNG MEN SHALL SEE VISIONS, YOUR OLD MEN SHALL DREAM DREAMS.

Act 2:18 AND ON MY MENSERVANTS AND ON MY MAIDSERVANTS I WILL POUR OUT MY SPIRIT IN THOSE DAYS; AND THEY SHALL PROPHESY.

Act 2:19 I WILL SHOW WONDERS IN HEAVEN ABOVE AND SIGNS IN THE EARTH BENEATH: BLOOD AND FIRE AND VAPOR OF SMOKE.

Act 2:20 THE SUN SHALL BE TURNED INTO DARKNESS, AND THE MOON INTO BLOOD, BEFORE THE COMING OF THE GREAT AND AWESOME DAY OF THE LORD.

Act 2:21 AND IT SHALL COME TO PASS THAT WHOEVER CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD SHALL BE SAVED.'

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 2:33 Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, **and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear.**

Act 2:34 "For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he says himself: 'THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND,

Act 2:35 TILL I MAKE YOUR ENEMIES YOUR FOOTSTOOL.' '

Act 2:36 "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."

Act 2:37 Now when they heard *this*, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men *and* brethren, what shall we do?"

Act 2:38 Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. (indwelling, and possibly the baptism/filling)

Act 2:39 **For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call.**

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Power to be His Witnesses

Act 4:7 And when they had set them in the midst, they asked, "By what power or by what name have you done this?"

Act 4:8 Then Peter, **filled with the Holy Spirit**, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel:

Act 4:9 If we this day are judged for a good deed *done* to a helpless man, by what means he has been made well,

Act 4:10 let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole.

Act 4:11 This is the 'STONE WHICH WAS REJECTED BY YOU BUILDERS, WHICH HAS BECOME THE CHIEF CORNERSTONE.'

Act 4:12 Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

Act 4:13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

Act 4:14 And seeing the man who had been healed standing with them, **they could say nothing against it.**

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 4:29 Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word,

Act 4:30 by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus."

Act 4:31 And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

Act 4:33 And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 5:28 saying, "Did we not strictly command you not to teach in this name? And look, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this Man's blood on us!"

Act 5:29 But Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men.

Act 5:30 The God of our fathers raised up **Jesus** whom you murdered by hanging on a tree.

Act 5:31 **Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior**, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.

Act 5:32 **And we are His witnesses to these things, and so also is the Holy Spirit whom God has given to those who obey Him.**"

- sadly, not all believers obey Him.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 6:3 Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of *good* reputation, **full of the Holy Spirit** and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business;

Act 6:4 but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word."

Act 6:5 And the saying pleased the whole multitude. And they chose Stephen, a man **full of faith and the Holy Spirit**, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch,

Act 6:6 whom they set before the apostles; and when they had prayed, they laid hands on them.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 6:8 And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and signs among the people.

Act 6:10 **And they were not able to resist the wisdom and the Spirit by which he spoke.** (resist - oppose, withstand, come against)

Act 6:11 Then they secretly induced men to say, "We have heard him speak blasphemous words against Moses and God."

Act 6:12 And they stirred up the people, the elders, and the scribes; and they came upon *him*, seized him, and brought *him* to the council.

Act 6:13 They also set up false witnesses who said, "This man does not cease to speak blasphemous words against this holy place and the law;

Act 6:14 for we have heard him say that this Jesus of Nazareth will destroy this place and change the customs which Moses delivered to us."

Act 6:15 **And all who sat in the council, looking steadfastly at him, saw his face as the face of an angel.**

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 7:55 But he, **being full of the Holy Spirit**, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God,

Act 7:56 and said, "Look! I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!"

Act 8:14 Now when the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them,

Act 8:15 who, when they had come down, **prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit.**

Act 8:16 For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Act 8:17 Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 10:44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word.

Act 10:45 And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, **because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also.**

Act 10:46 For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God. Then Peter answered,

Act 10:47 "Can anyone forbid water, that these should not be baptized **who have received the Holy Spirit just as we *have*?"**

- this was something visible, demonstrable

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 11:15 And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit **fell** upon them, as upon us at the beginning.

Act 11:16 Then I remembered the word of the Lord, how He said, 'John indeed baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit.'

Act 11:17 If therefore God gave them the same gift as He gave us when we believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could withstand God?

Act 11:18 When they heard these things they became silent; and they glorified God, saying, "Then God has also granted to the Gentiles repentance to life.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 13:49 **And the word of the Lord was being spread throughout all the region.** (power to be His witnesses)

Act 13:50 But the Jews stirred up the devout and prominent women and the chief men of the city, raised up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their region.

Act 13:51 But they shook off the dust from their feet against them, and came to Iconium.

Act 13:52 **And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit.** (joy, a fruit or evidence of the Holy Spirit)

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

Act 19:1 And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that Paul, having passed through the upper regions, came to **Ephesus**. And finding some disciples

Act 19:2 he said to them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" So they said to him, "We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit."

Act 19:3 And he said to them, "Into what then were you baptized?" So they said, "Into John's baptism."

Act 19:4 Then Paul said, "John indeed baptized with a baptism of repentance, saying to the people that they should believe on Him who would come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus."

Act 19:5 When they heard *this*, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus.

Act 19:6 And when Paul had laid hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them, and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.

The Baptism of the Holy Spirit

CLOSING

Mat 9:17 Nor do they put new wine into old wineskins, or else the wineskins break, the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But they put new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved."

Act 3:19 Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord

Luk 11:13 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"**
