







## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Act 1:6-8** Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. **But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.**"

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

### Fruit of the Spirit

Gal 5:22 But the **fruit of the Spirit** is **love**, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Gal 5:23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

Gal 5:24 And those *who are* Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

Gal 5:25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

**Love** – singular, not plural

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Joh 15:8** By this My Father is glorified, **that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.**

**Joh 15:9** "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; **abide in My love.**

**Joh 15:10** If you keep My commandments, you will **abide in My love**, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His **love**.

**Joh 15:11** "These things I have spoken to you, **that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full.**

**Joh 15:12** This is My commandment, **that you love one another** as I have loved you.

**1Th 4:9** But concerning brotherly love you have no need that I should write to you, **for you yourselves are taught by God to love one another;**

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Eph 4:1** I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, entreat you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,

**Php 1:27** Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ; so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

**Col 1:10** so that you may walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please Him in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

**1Th 2:12** so that you may walk in a manner worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory.

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Eph 3:14** For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

**Eph 3:15** from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

**Eph 3:16** that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man,

**Eph 3:17** that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love,

**Eph 3:18** may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—

**Eph 3:19** to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

**Eph 3:20** Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,

**Eph 3:21** to Him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Joh 15:13** Greater **love** has no one than this, than to lay down one's life for his friends.

**Joh 15:14** You are My friends if you do whatever I command you.

**Joh 15:15** No longer do I call you servants, for a servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all things that I heard from My Father I have made known to you.

**Joh 15:16** You did not choose Me, but I chose you and **appointed you that you should go and bear fruit**, and *that* your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you.

**Joh 15:17** These things I command you, that you **love** one another.

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

Gal 5:22 But the **fruit** of the Spirit is **love**, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,

Gal 5:23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

Gal 5:24 And those *who are* Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

Gal 5:25 If we **live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.**

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Mrk 12:30** **AND YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, WITH ALL YOUR MIND, AND WITH ALL YOUR STRENGTH.'** This *is* the first commandment.

**Mrk 12:31** And the second, like *it, is* this: '**YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.'** There is no other commandment greater than these."

**1Jn 4:8** He who does not love does not know God, **for God is love.**

**1Jn 4:16** And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. **God is love**, and **he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.**

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Jhn 13:3** Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from God and was going to God,

**Jhn 13:4** rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself.

**Jhn 13:5** After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe *them* with the towel with which He was girded.

**Jhn 13:6** Then He came to Simon Peter. And *Peter* said to Him, "Lord, are You washing my feet?"

**Jhn 13:7** Jesus answered and said to him, "**What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this.**"

**Jhn 13:8** Peter said to Him, "You shall never wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "**If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me.**"

**Jhn 13:9** Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, not my feet only, but also *my* hands and *my* head!"

**Jhn 13:10** Jesus said to him, "**He who is bathed needs only to wash *his* feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you.**"

**Jhn 13:11** For He knew who would betray Him; therefore He said, "**You are not all clean.**"

**Jhn 13:12** So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "**Do you know what I have done to you?**

**Jhn 13:13** You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, *for so I am.*

**Jhn 13:14** If I then, *your* Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, **you also ought to wash one another's feet.**

**Jhn 13:15** For **I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.**

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Joh 13:34** A new commandment I give to you, that you **love** one another; as I have loved you, that you also **love** one another.

**Joh 13:35** By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have **love** for one another.”

**Rom 5:5** Now hope does not disappoint, because **the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.**

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**1Co 13:1** If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.

**1Co 13:2** And if I have *the gift of prophecy*, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.

**1Co 13:3** And if I give all my possessions to feed *the poor*, and if I deliver my body to be burned, but do not have love, it profits me nothing.

**1Co 13:4** Love is patient, love is kind, *and* is not jealous; love does not brag *and* is not arrogant,

**1Co 13:5** does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong *suffered*,

**1Co 13:6** does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth;

**1Co 13:7** bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

**1Co 13:8** Love never fails;

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

In 1 John 36x LOVE is used

**1Jn 3:18** My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but **in deed and in truth.**

**1Jn 3:23** And this is **His commandment**: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ **and love one another**, as He gave us commandment.

**1Jn 4:7** Beloved, **let us love one another**, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God.

**1Jn 4:11** Beloved, if God so loved us, **we also ought to love one another.**

**1Jn 4:12** No one has seen God at any time. **If we love one another**, God abides in us, **and His love has been perfected in us.**

**1Jn 4:16** And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and **he who abides in love abides in God**, and God in him.

**1Jn 4:21** And this commandment we have from Him: that **he who loves God must love his brother also.**

**1Jn 5:2** By this **we know that we love the children of God**, when we love God and keep His commandments.

**1Jn 5:3** For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Love** – unconquerable benevolence. No matter what anyone may do to us by way of insult or injury or humiliation, we will never seek anything but that person's highest good. Never to seek anything but the best for a person even when that person seeks the worst for us.

### ~The rest of the fruit describe what love looks like~

- **Joy** - chara, In Your presence is fullness of joy.
- **Peace** - serenity and good order, tranquility of heart
  - Php 4:7 and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.
- **Longsuffering or patience** – conquering patience, specifically patience toward people, not things. Those slow to anger. One who could avenge himself and yet does not. The attitude of God towards man.
- **Kindness** – sweetness, mellowness, one who can only help, not harm
- **Goodness** – strong kindness, a virtue which never fails to seek another person's best in all ways
- **Faithfulness** – fidelity, trustworthy, reliable
- **Gentleness** – submissive to the will of God, teachable, never too proud to learn, being considerate. An animal that has been tamed and brought under control. This can only come from Jesus' influence in our lives.
  - *The word has the idea of being teachable, not having a superior attitude, not demanding one's rights. It isn't timidity or passiveness*
- **Self-control** – self-mastery, to overcome and control desires and pleasures and love of pleasures. Secular Greek uses it of an emperor who never lets his private interests influence the government of his people. Full and complete objectivity.

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

**Joh 17:26** And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare *it*, that the **love** with which You loved Me **may be in them, and I in them.**"

- Jesus sent the Holy Spirit
- The Spirit would testify of and point to Jesus
- The fruit of the Spirit is LOVE
- The love of God, manifest in us, points to...Jesus
- And we ARE His witnesses

## Evidence of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit – Fruit of Love

### CLOSING

**Mat 9:17** Nor do they put new wine into old wineskins, or else the wineskins break, the wine is spilled, and the wineskins are ruined. But they put new wine into new wineskins, and both are preserved."

**Luk 11:13** If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"**
