





The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

The Trinity – Father, Son, Holy Spirit

Mat 3:13-17 Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan to be baptized by him. And John *tried to* prevent Him, saying, "I need to be baptized by You, and are You coming to me?" But Jesus answered and said to him, "**Permit it to be so now, for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness.**" Then he allowed Him. When He had been baptized, **Jesus** came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened to **Him**, and **He** saw **the Spirit of God** descending like a **dove** and alighting upon Him. And suddenly **a voice came from heaven**, saying, "**This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.**"

1Jn 5:7 For there are three that bear witness in heaven: **the Father, the Word, and the Holy Spirit; and these three are one.**

The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

The Trinity – Father, Son, Holy Spirit

Luk 24:49 Behold, I send the Promise of My Father upon you; but tarry in the city of Jerusalem until you are endued with power from on high."

The Promise of the Holy Spirit

Act 1:1-5 The former account I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach, until the day in which He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen, to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God. And being assembled together with *them*, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

John 14:16-17 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.

The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

Intelligence, Will, Emotion

Intelligence

1Co 2:10-11 But God has revealed *them* to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God.

1Co 2:13 These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

Intelligence, Will, Emotion

Will

1Co 12:11 But one and the same Spirit **works all these things, **distributing** to each one individually as He wills.**

Act 15:28 For it seemed good to the Holy Spirit, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things:

Act 16:6-7 Now when they had gone through Phrygia and the region of Galatia, they were **forbidden by the Holy Spirit to preach the word in Asia. After they had come to Mysia, they tried to go into Bithynia, but **the Spirit did not permit them.****

The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

Intelligence, Will, Emotion

Emotion

Eph 4:30 And do not **grieve** the Holy Spirit of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. (Grieve – to be sorrowful or sad)

Isa 63:9-11, 14 In all their affliction He was afflicted, And the Angel of His Presence saved them; In His love and in His pity He redeemed them; And He bore them and carried them All the days of old. But they rebelled and **grieved** His Holy Spirit; So He turned Himself against them as an enemy, *And* He fought against them. Then he remembered the days of old, Moses *and* his people, *saying*: "Where *is* He who brought them up out of the sea With the shepherd of His flock? Where *is* He who put His Holy Spirit within them... And the Spirit of the LORD causes him to rest..."

Rom 15:30 Now I beg you, brethren, through the Lord Jesus Christ, and through the **love** of the Spirit, that you strive together with me in prayers to God for me,

The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit treated as a Person in the Scriptures

Act 5:3 But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart **to lie to the Holy Spirit** and keep back *part* of the price of the land for yourself?

Act 5:4 While it remained, was it not your own? And after it was sold, was it not in your own control? Why have you conceived this thing in your heart?
You have not lied to men but to God."

Act 7:51 "You stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You always **resist the Holy Spirit**; as your fathers *did*, so *do* you.

Mar 3:28 "Assuredly, I say to you, all sins will be forgiven the sons of men, and whatever blasphemies they may utter;

Mar 3:29 but he who **blasphemes against the Holy Spirit** never has forgiveness, but is subject to eternal condemnation"—

The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit speaks as a Person in the Scriptures

Act 13:2 As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, **the Holy Spirit said**, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them."

1Ti 4:1 Now **the Spirit expressly says** that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,

Rev 2:7 "He who has an ear, let him hear **what the Spirit says to the churches**. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God." ‘

Rom 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also **helps** in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself **makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered**.

Rom 8:27 Now He who searches the hearts knows what **the mind of the Spirit is**, because **He makes intercession** for the saints according to *the will of God*.

The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

The Spirit of God is Eternal

Gen 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

Gen 1:2 The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

- (Elohim, more than one within one)

Gen 1:26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

The Spirit of God possesses Divine attributes

He is **Omnipresent** - Ps 139:7

Psa 139:7-10 Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend into heaven, You *are* there; If I make my bed in hell, behold, You *are there*. *If* I take the wings of the morning, And dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, Even there Your hand shall lead me, And Your right hand shall hold me.

He is **Omniscient** - 1 Cor 2:10

1Co 2:10-11 But God has revealed *them* to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so **no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God.**

The Person and Deity of the Holy Spirit

The Spirit of God possesses Divine attributes

He is **Omnipotent** - Luke 1

Luk 1:35 And the angel answered and said to her, "**The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest** will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God.

He is **Eternal** – Heb 9

Heb 9:13-14 For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through **the eternal Spirit** offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

He is **Sovereign** – 1 Cor 12

1Co 12:11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually **as He wills**.
