How does covenant theology help practically?

- how to read the Bible
- communion with God
- the person and work of Christ
- how we know that truly we belong to God and can be certainly assured of salvation
- sacraments (baptism and the Lord's Supper)

WHAT IS COVENANT THEOLOGY

A theological framework arising from scripture that understands God's work in history by way of covenants.

Three covenants in particular:

- The Covenant of Redemption
- The Covenant of Works
- The Covenant of Grace

GOD'S WORK IN HISTORY

Through these three covenant God shows the answer to vital questions that are at the very heart of our faith

- What is God doing?
- Where do we fit into it?

FRAMEWORK

Hermeneutics is the science of interpretation- the methods used to go about understanding what something means.

Everyone has a hermeneutic – whether you realize it or not. The question is does your hermeneutic get you to a right understanding?

CT's hermeneutic is exegetical- meaning it comes from the text of scripture itself. Which is to say that it is a way of interpreting Scripture that Scripture itself provides.

COVENANT

Berit in hebrew *Diathek*e in greek

Covenant = guaranteed commitment (Renihan)

In God's covenant with us, there is not a negotiation. He is the creator, we are his creatures so he lays out the terms.
