

Setting the Scene – An Intro to Titus

As we get ready to begin studying Titus together, start by reading the letter aloud together. Before you do, take a look at the questions below and keep them in mind as you read/listen:

- 1) What are some things that stand out and encourage you from Titus?**
- 2) What questions has Titus raised that you look forward to exploring as we study this letter over the next few months?**

Take a few minutes to pray for our church. Pray that God would provide all we need, that the gospel would be guarded and proclaimed in our midst, and that we would be protected from error and division.

As we get ready to take a break for July to dive into covenant theology class as a church, let's spend some significant time praying for each other. Use these categories to share with each other how we can bear your burdens by going before the father for you:

- **Cares – What is troubling you right now? In what ways are you facing suffering? What are you afraid of or anxious about?**
- **Confession – What sin can you confess? What do you need to ask God to repent you of? What temptations do you seem to be facing?**
- **Comforts – In what ways have you witnessed God's care for you? How have you received mercy and grace in times of need?**
