The Definition of Calcedon

We, then, following the holy Fathers, all with one consent, teach men to confess one and the same Son, our Lord Jesus Christ: the same perfect in deity

and also perfect in humanity;

truly God and truly man, of a rational soul and body; consubstantial with the Father concerning His divine nature, and consubstantial with us according to His human nature;

in all things like unto us, but without sin;

begotten before all ages of the Father

concerning His divine nature,

and in these latter days, for us and for our salvation,

born of the Virgin Mary,

the Mother of God, concerning His human nature;

One and the same Christ, Son, Lord, Only begotten,

to be acknowledged in two natures,

unconfusedly, unchangeably, indivisibly, inseparably;

the distinction of natures being by no means taken away by the union,

but rather the property of each nature being preserved,

and concurring in one Person and one Subsistence,

not parted or divided into two persons,

but one and the same Son, and only begotten,

God the Word.

As the prophets from the beginning have declared concerning Him, and the Lord Jesus Christ Himself has taught us, and the Creed of the holy Fathers has handed down to us.
