Jesus' Road to the Cross

- The shouting crowd (Hosanna/Crucify Him)
- The kangaroo trial and conviction
- The Scourging/Flogging
- The carrying of the cross beam to the place of crucifixion
- The nailing to the cross & being raised high
- The sign with His name and the charges was placed over His head



3 Cross-Facts

- Jesus Fulfilled Prophecy (15:27-28; Acts 2:23; Gen. 3:15; Is. 53:3-7, 12)
- Jesus Felt Pain (15:29-36)
 - **Personally** (15:29-32; Ps. 22:7-8)
 - Judicially (15:33-36; Ps. 22:1; Is. 53:10-11; 2 Cor. 5:21)
- Jesus Fully Pardoned (15:37-39; Jn. 12:32; Rom. 10:13; Heb. 10:19-20)





The Roman Centurion

- Centurion (centum) meaning one hundred. They commanded one hundred men; an honorable position
- Committed to putting the mission before comfort, their comrades before self, and obedience to duty above their personal opinions about the orders given
- They were men of battle, who knew how to implement strategy provide security protection, and they oversaw executions



The Roman Centurion

- Position
- Prominence
- Power
- Prestige
