

“When Rebellion Meets Reality”

Jude 5-11

1. Remember God’s Past Warnings (5)

- A. (Heb 3:15), “...Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion.” NKJV
- B. (1 Co 10:12) "Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall." NKJV

2. Recognize God’s Present Watchfulness (6)

- A. (2 Pe 2:4) "...God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment;" NKJV
- B. (Pr 15:3) "The eyes of the LORD are in every place, Keeping watch on the evil and the good." NKJV

3. Realize God’s Future Wrath (7-11)

- A. (Ro 6:23) "For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." NKJV
- B. (Is 1:18) "'Come now, and let us reason together,' Says the LORD, 'Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow; Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool.'" NKJV

Write-up

In this message from Jude 5–11, we see what happens *when rebellion meets reality*—how God’s past judgments reveal His unchanging response to unbelief and His mercy that still calls us home. Through vivid examples of Israel, the angels, and Sodom, Jude reminds us that truth must guide faith, not feelings. This passage invites us to turn from compromise, trust God’s authority, and walk securely in the grace of the One who rescues and restores.
