## 2 Timothy 3:13-17

Sunday, October 2, 2022

### 1. Being Aware of Satan’s Deception (13)

A. “Motives are important but they aren’t everything”

B. (2 Co 4:3–4) <sup>13</sup> But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, <sup>4</sup> whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.” NKJV

### 2. Putting Faith in God’s Salvation (14-15)

A. (Ga 3:24–25) <sup>24</sup> Therefore the law was our tutor to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith. <sup>25</sup> But after faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.” NKJV

### 3. Understanding God’s Revelation (16-17)

A. (1 Jn 5:13) “These things I have written to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may continue to believe in the name of the Son of God.” NKJV

B. (Mt 5:14–15) <sup>14</sup> “You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup> Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house.” NKJV

C. (Mt 5:16) “Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.” NKJV

D. (2 Th 2:7) “For the mystery of lawlessness is already at work; only He who now restrains will do so until He is taken out of the way.” NKJV
