

# “Take Heed How You Hear”

Luke 8:1-39

## 1. Hear His Word (1–18)

A. (Jas 1:22) "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves." NKJV

## 2. Trust His Word (19–25)

A. (Pr 3:5–6) "<sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; <sup>6</sup> In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths." NKJV

B. (2 Co 5:7) "For we walk by faith, not by sight." NKJV

## 3. Christ's Forgiveness Brings Peace (48-50)

A. (2 Co 5:17) "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new." NKJV

B. (Heb 1:1–2) "<sup>1</sup> God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, <sup>2</sup> has in these last days spoken to us by His Son, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;" NKJV

C. (Heb 3:7–8) "<sup>7</sup> Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: “Today, if you will hear His voice, <sup>8</sup> Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, In the day of trial in the wilderness," NKJV

In this message covering *Luke 8:1-39*, we see that Jesus' authority calls for more than admiration—it calls for a response. As we **take heed how we hear**, we discover that God's Word reveals the condition of our hearts, faith trusts Christ even in life's storms, and genuine hearing always leads to obedience.
