## 1. His Arrival (1-11)

- A. (Ac 4:4) "However, many of those who heard the word believed; and the number of the men came to be about five thousand." NKJV
- B. Principle: "Walking with Him is the only way to experience His plan and purpose for your life"

## 2. His Actions (12-19)

- A. (Lk 19:41–44) "<sup>41</sup> Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it, <sup>42</sup> saying, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things that make for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes. <sup>43</sup> For days will come upon you when your enemies will build an embankment around you, surround you and close you in on every side, <sup>44</sup> and level you, and your children within you, to the ground; and they will not leave in you one stone upon another, because you did not know the time of your visitation." NKJV
- B. (Jn 15:1–2) "<sup>1</sup> "I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. <sup>2</sup> Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit." NKJV
- C. (1 Pe 4:17) "For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God?" NKJV
