1. Listen Carefully (19-21)

- A. (1 Th 2:13) "For this reason we also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe." NKJV

2. Look Honestly (22-25)

- A. (Heb 4:12) "For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discernor of the thoughts and intents of the heart." NKJV

3. Live Consistently (26-27)

- A. (Pr 13:3) "He who guards his mouth preserves his life, But he who opens wide his lips shall have destruction." NKJV
- B. (1 Jn 3:18) "My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth." NKJV
