1. The Proof of True Wisdom (13)

- A. (Mt 5:16) “Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven” NKJV
- B. (1 Co 8:1) “...Knowledge puffs up, but love edifies.” NKJV

2. The Pitfalls of False Wisdom (14-16)

- A. (Pr 14:30) “A sound heart is life to the body, but envy is rottenness to the bones.” NKJV

3. The Power of Godly Wisdom (17-18)

- A. (Pr 9:10) “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding” NKJV
- B. (Mt 5:8) “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God” NKJV
- C. (Pr 3:17) says of wisdom, “Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace.” NKJV

In **Two Sources of Wisdom** from James 3:13–18, discover the difference between worldly wisdom that leads to confusion and godly wisdom that produces peace.
