## 1. Tenderness (1-5)

A. (Isaiah 66:13) “As one whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you; and you shall be comforted in Jerusalem.” NKJV

## 2. Godliness (5)

A. (Ac 16:1) “Then he came to Derbe and Lystra. And behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timothy, the son of a certain Jewish woman who believed, but his father was Greek.” NKJV

## 3. Boldness (6-7)

A. (Ps 127:3-4) <sup>3</sup> Behold, children are a heritage from the LORD, the fruit of the womb is a reward. <sup>4</sup> Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, so are the children of one’s youth.” NKJV
