

“The Grace That Saves”

Titus 2:11-15

Sunday, January 30, 2022

1. Intro

A. (2 Co 5:17) "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new." NKJV

2. It Brings Salvation (11)

A. (Jn 1:1) "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God." NKJV

B. (Jn 1:14) "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth." NKJV

C. (Jn 1:16–18) "¹⁶ And of His fullness we have all received, and grace for grace. ¹⁷ For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ. ¹⁸ No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared Him." NKJV

D. (Eph 2:8–9) "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not of works, lest anyone should boast." NKJV

E. (Jn 8:34–36) "³⁴ Jesus answered them, “Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. ³⁵ And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever. ³⁶ Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.” NKJV

3. It Works Sanctification (12-15)

A. (2 Co 4:16) "Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day." NKJV

B. (Php 4:12–13) "¹² I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. ¹³ I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." NKJV

4. It Promises Glorification (13)

A. (Jn 14:1–3) "¹ “Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ² In My Father’s house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.” NKJV

B. (Ac 1:11) "...“Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven.”” NKJV

C. (1 Th 4:15–18) "¹⁵ For this we say to you by the word of the Lord, that we who are alive and remain until the coming of the Lord will by no means precede those who are asleep. ¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. ¹⁷ Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. ¹⁸ Therefore comfort one another with these words." NKJV

D. (Mt 24:29–30) "²⁹ “Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. ³⁰ Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.” NKJV

E. (Ro 10:11–13) "¹¹ For the Scripture says, “Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.” ¹² For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. ¹³ For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.”” NKJV
