Luke 5:27-39

1. He Changes Who We Follow (27–28)

- A. (Jn 6:68) "But Simon Peter answered Him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life." NKJV
- B. (2 Co 5:17) "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new." NKJV

2. He Changes Where We Belong (29–32)

- A. (Ps 147:3) "He heals the brokenhearted And binds up their wounds." NKJV
- B. (Jn 13:35) "By this all will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another." NKJV

3. He Changes What We Trust (33–39)

- A. (Ga 5:16–18) "¹⁶ I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. ¹⁷ For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. ¹⁸ But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law." NKJV
- B. (Ro 8:5) "For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit." NKJV
- C. (Ro 8:14) "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God." NKJV
- D. (Je 7:4) "Do not trust in these lying words, saying, 'The temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD, the temple of the LORD are these.'" NKJV
