1. Faith Obeys (1-6)

- A. (Heb 11:8) "By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to the place which he would receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going." NKJV

2. Faith Endures (7-9)

- A. (Ga 1:10) "For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to please men? For if I still pleased men, I would not be a bondservant of Christ." NKJV

3. Faith Depends (10-17)

- A. (2 Co 12:9) "9 And He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me." NKJV
