## 1 Timothy 1:12-20

### 1. Intro

A. (Php 2:19–20) <sup>19</sup> But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you shortly, that I also may be encouraged when I know your state. <sup>20</sup> For I have no one like-minded, who will sincerely care for your state." NKJV

A. Paul was called

(1) (Eph 2:10) "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them." NKJV

(2) (Mt 5:14–16) <sup>14</sup> "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. <sup>15</sup> Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. <sup>16</sup> Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven." NKJV

### 3. A Glorious Pardon (13-14)

A. (Lk 23:34) "Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." And they divided His garments and cast lots." NKJV

B. (2 Pe 3:9) "The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance." NKJV

A. (2 Co 4:3–4) <sup>3</sup> But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, <sup>4</sup> whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them." NKJV
