1. Surrender Your Conversations (11-12)

- A. (Pr 18:21) “Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit.” NKJV
- B. (Mt 12:36) “But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment.” NKJV

2. Surrender Your Calendar (13-14)

- A. (Pr 27:1) reminds us: “Do not boast about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth.” NKJV
- B. (Ps 33:10–11) says: “The Lord brings the counsel of the nations to nothing; He makes the plans of the peoples of no effect. The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations.” NKJV

3. Surrender Your Choices (15-17)

In “Tomorrow Belongs to God” from James 4:11–17, James challenges us to stop tearing others down with our words, to stop presuming on tomorrow with our plans, and to stop delaying obedience. Instead, we’re called to humility—speaking life, surrendering our schedules, and doing today what God has asked. Discover how living this way positions you exactly where He wants you to be tomorrow.
