1. A Desperation that Leads to Jesus (21-24)

A. “God whispers to us in our pleasures, but He shouts to us in our pains. Pain is God’s megaphone to rouse a deaf world” C.S. Lewis

B. (1 Pe 1:6–9) ⁶“In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, ⁷ that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ, ⁸ whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, ⁹ receiving the end of your faith—the salvation of your souls.” NKJV

2. The Faith to Reach for Jesus (25-34)

A. (Mic 6:8) “He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?” NKJV

3. A Willingness to Give Control to Jesus (35-43)

A. (Jn 11:25) “Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live.” NKJV
