Luke 1:1-4

## 1. Introduction

- A. (Ge 49:10) "The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes; And to Him shall be the obedience of the people." NKJV
- B. MATTHEW – Pictures Jesus as the fulfillment of Jewish prophecy, ‘Promised Messiah’
- C. MARK – Pictures Jesus as the ‘Servant of God’
- D. JOHN – Pictures Jesus as the ‘Son of God’
- E. LUKE – Pictures Jesus as the ‘Son of Man’

## 2. His Promise Has Been Fulfilled (1)

- A. (2 Co 1:20) "For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us." NKJV

## 3. His Life Was Seen by Witnesses (2)

- A. (2 Pe 1:16) "For we did not follow cunningly devised fables when we made known to you the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but were eyewitnesses of His majesty." NKJV
- B. (1 Jn 1:3) "That which we have seen and heard we declare to you..." NKJV

## 4. His Gospel Was Carefully Recorded (3-4)

- A. (Ps 119:160) "The entirety of Your word is truth, and every one of Your righteous judgments endures forever." NKJV
- B. (Jn 17:17) "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth." NKJV
