## 1. The Heart is Revealed by Conflict (27-38)

- A. (Pr 23:7) "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he. "Eat and drink!" he says to you, But his heart is not with you." NKJV
- B. (Eph 5:1) "Therefore be imitators of God as dear children." NKJV

## 2. The Heart is Reflected in Character (39-45)

- A. (1 Co 15:33) "Do not be deceived: "Evil company corrupts good habits."" NKJV
- B. (Pr 4:23) "Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life." NKJV

## 3. The Heart is Exposed by Christ (46-49)

- A. (Jas 1:22) "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves." NKJV
- B. (Jn 13:17) "If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them." NKJV

In this message from *Luke 6:27–49*, we see Jesus lovingly search the heart through conflict, character, and obedience. As He speaks about enemies, judgment, fruit, and foundations, He reveals that the pressures of life do not create what is in us—they expose it.
