1. Strengthen Your Faith through Devotion (20–21)

- A. (Ac 20:32) "So now, brethren, I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified." NKJV
- B. (Col 2:7) "rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith, as you have been taught, abounding in it with thanksgiving." NKJV

2. Show God's Heart through Compassion (22–23)

- A. (Zech 3:2) "...Is this not a brand plucked from the fire?" NKJV
- B. (Jas 5:19–20) "19 Brethren, if anyone among you wanders from the truth, and someone turns him back, 20 let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins." NKJV
- C. (Ga 6:1) "Brethren, if a man is overtaken in any trespass, you who are spiritual restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness, considering yourself lest you also be tempted." NKJV

3. Stand in His Power with Confidence (24–25)

- A. (Php 1:6) "being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;" NKJV
- B. (Ps 37:24) "Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; For the LORD upholds him with His hand." NKJV
